Application fee AVAC service fee (This only applies to paper applications lodged at an AVAC – in person or by mail, it does	
not apply to applications lodged via ImmiAccount)	
High quality copy of the Birth Certificate of the applicant	
Endorsed passport sized photograph of the applicant (see Form 118 for further information)	
Evidence of all changes of name of the applicant and/or their parents (if applicable)	
Evidence that at least one parent was an Australian citizen at the time of the applicant's birth, such as an Australian Passport issued after 1 July 2005, full Australian birth certificate, or certificate of Australian citizenship	
Any orders relating to the custody, guardianship or parental responsibility for an applicant under the age of 18, if applicable.	
Where the applicant is under 18 years of age, the written consent, contact number, and front page of passport of the parent who is not the responsible parent in the application, if applicable.	
Identity documents for the responsible parent who is applying on behalf of a child under 16 years of age which collectively show a signature, photograph and current address (such as a passport, drivers licence, credit card or utilities bill)	_
Evidence of the current residential address for the applicant and/or responsible parents - this should be consistent with the address provided on your application form.	
Parents' marriage certificate (if married)	
If parents were not married at the time of the applicant's birth, evidence of their de facto relationship at the time of the applicant's birth, such as:	
 a statement in English about their relationship including when and where they met and whether they live together 	
statements from friends and relatives attesting to their relationship	
evidence of joint addresses and joint ownership of assets	
 employment certificates for both parents details of Chinese visas and temporary residence authorities for the parent/s to reside in their current 	
place of residence	
Family photos (maximum of 3)	
Hukou showing current place of residence
