

Training and Research visa (Subclass 402)

Application Checklist - CHINA

This visa is for people who want to come to Australia on a temporary basis to participate in occupational training, observe or participate in research as a visiting academic, or participate in a professional development program. This is not a work visa.

This document lists the information and supporting documents required to lodge a complete application. It also lists additional documents that you may need to provide depending on your individual circumstances.

Important:

- Please provide an email address on the application form as this is the easiest way to communicate with you.
- Please do not send any original documents.
- Documents not in English must be accompanied by accredited English translations.

Research stream: lodge your completed application form with all the required documents and pay the visa application charge at any Australian Visa Application Centre (AVAC) in China.	
Occupational Trainee stream/Professional Development stream: lodge your completed application form with all the required documents and pay the visa application charge at the Hobart office in Tasmania - attention Specialist Temporary Entry Centre

Certified copies of marriage certificates or relationship registrations for you and anyone else	
included in your application, even if they are not joining you in Australia	
If you are living in a de facto relationship: independent evidence that your relationship is genuine and continuing (for example, joint bank account statements, billing accounts in joint names or joint ownership of major assets).	
If you or anyone included in the application has been widowed, divorced or permanently separated: a certified copy of the death certificate, divorce documents, or <u>statutory declaration</u> separation documents.	
Evidence of financial dependency for all your family members aged 18 or older:	
a certified copy of their birth certificate and proof of their relationship to you	
proof that they live in your household	
proof that they have been financially dependent on you for at least the 12 months immediately before you lodge your application.	

Your children	-
Certified copies of birth certificates or the family book showing the names of both parents of all your dependent children.	
If any dependent child included in the application is adopted: certified copies of the adoption papers.	
If you want to bring a child younger than 18 years of age with you to Australia, and that child's other parent is not included in the application: documentary evidence that you have the legal right to bring that child to Australia, such as:	
 certified copies of official legal documents, such as a court-issued parental responsibility (custody), access or guardianship order 	
 Form 1229 Consent form to grant an Australian visa to a child under the age of 18 years together with a certified copy of the other parent's government-issued identification document (such as a passport or National ID card). 	
Military service	1
If anyone included in the application has served in the armed forces of any country: certified copies of their military service record or discharge papers.	
Penal Certificate	1
If your stay in Australia, including any time already spent in Australia is more than 12 months, you must provide the ORIGINAL police clearance for each applicant who is 16 years of age or older	
Health Insurance	
Evidence with your visa application that you have adequate health insurance for the duration of your stay in Australia. Evidence of insurance may be: A certification letter from your health insurer or broker	
Evidence that you have enrolled with Medicare if your country has a <u>reciprocal health</u>	
arrangement with Australia	
 The health insurance standard template letter completed by your insurance provider see: <u>Health Insurance Standard Template Letter</u> 	
Note: as a guide to the level of health insurance the department will accept as adequate, review 'Attachment A' to the health insurance standard template letter.	
Purpose of Visit	1
This visa has three streams:	
 Research stream: for professional academics invited to visit Australia to observe or participate in an Australian research project at an Australian tertiary or research institution. This can be lodged in China. 	
Occupational Trainee stream: for people who need structured workplace-based training to enhance their skills in their current occupation, area of tertiary study, or field of expertise.	
• Professional Development stream: for professionals, managers or government officials invited to participate in a professional development training program in Australia. The program must have been arranged by an employer outside Australia and usually lasts up to 18 months.	
Please refer to the additional stream specific documentary requirements for your purpose	
below. Research stream

 Letter of invitation from the office of the Registrar (or equivalent administrative office) of the relevant institution or research organisation for the purpose of observing or participating in an Australian research project at the institution in collaboration with other academics employed by the sponsoring institution. This is not a letter issued by the relevant faculty but from the central administrative office of the institution. 	
 The letter should identify the Australian research project*, including: the title of the Australian research project the Australian research project identification number (if available) 	

	- the nature of the Australian research project	
	- funding sources for the Australian research project	
	 your duty statement or responsibilities in observing or participating in the Australian research project 	
•	The letter should also indicate the following:	
	- proposed period of stay	
	- weekly hours of employment or activity	
	- statement of essential skills and qualification required for the position	
	- proposed allowance, if any, from the inviting institution	
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	lease note: If you are not able to identify the Australian research project, this is not the propriate visa subclass and/or stream for your purpose.	
•	Evidence of your academic employment:	
	- a statement from your home institution acknowledging the invitation; or	
	- evidence that you were previously employed as an academic at a tertiary or research	
	institution. Specify academic title (ie Professor, Associate Professor, Lecturer).	
•	Evidence that you have a significant record of achievement in your field, including:	
	- your current curriculum vitae (CV)	
	- a list of published work.

•	If you are sponsored by a Commonwealth agency: a copy of the invitation to participate in the	
	training.	
•	If you are not sponsored by a Commonwealth agency: a copy of the nomination approval	
	letter or receipt for lodgement of the sponsorship application.	
•	A copy of your qualifications and curriculum vitae (CV).	
•	If registrations or licences are required for you to do the training: copies of registrations or licences.	
•	If you hold or have held a Student visa: evidence of successful completion of the principal	
	course.	
Pr	ofessional Development stream	1
•	A letter of offer from your sponsor inviting you to participate in the professional development program.	
•	A statement from your sponsor confirming that they are satisfied:	
	- that you are doing the professional development training specified in the application	
	- with your level of English language proficiency for the purposes of the program	
	- that you have relevant managerial or other professional skills and work experience to	
	participate in the program.	
•	A signed letter on company letterhead from your current manager detailing your current position and duties.	
•	A copy of your qualifications and curriculum vitae (CV)	
•	If not directly employed by the Government body listed in the 1402A form, the overseas Government body must provide a letter of invitation confirming that they support your participation in the program.
