- Please DO NOT send any original documents, unless you are requested to do so.
- Any documents in a language other than English **MUST** be accompanied by an English translation.

Application Fee AVAC service fee (This only applies to paper applications lodged at an AVAC- in person or by mail, it does not apply to applications lodge via Immi Account)	
High quality color copy of the Birth Certificate of the applicant	
Endorsed passport sized photograph of the applicant (see Form118 or Form1195 for further information)	
Evidence of all changes of name of the applicant and/or the parents (if applicable)	
Evidence that at least one parent was an Australian citizen at the time of the applicant's birth, such as an Australian Passport issued after 1 July 2005, full Australian birth certificate, or certificate of Australian citizenship.	
Note: the parents identification provided should include a copy of the identification document recorded on the applicant's birth certificate	
Any orders relating to the custody, guardianship or parental responsibility for an applicant under the age of 18, if applicable	
Where the applicant is under 18 years of age, the written consent, contact number, and identification document such as a front page of the passport or a Chinese ID copy for BOTH parents	
Note: the parents' identification provided should include a copy of the identification document recorded on the applicant's birth certificate	
Parents' marriage certificate (if married), and/or evidence of their relationship at the time of the applicant's conception, for example:	

•	A statement in English about their relationship including when and where they met and whether they live together, how the relationship developed		
•	Statements from friends and relatives attesting to their relationship		
•	Evidence of joint ownership of assets and/or joint lease contract prior to when the child was conceived		
•	Evidence of joint address (utility bills, credit card records or mails prior to when the child was conceived)		
•	Evidence of joint trip(s) prior to the child's conception (air tickets, boarding pass, hotel accommodation, photos)		
•	Up to ten family photos taken at different stages (i.e. during pregnancy, in hospital, after birth, etc.)

•	the current correspondence address in Chinese,
