First 462 Visa Application Checklist - CHINA

Use this checklist to ensure that you have the main documents we need to assess your application.

You must give us a copy of all relevant documents with your application. We may decide it only on the information that you gave us when you applied. In some cases, we may ask for more information.

If you didn't [attach all documents](#) when you applied, attach them via ImmiAccount as soon as you can.

Provide evidence that you have or have access to sufficient funds for personal support while you are in Australia and to leave Australia at the end of your stay - at least AUD 5,000 for your initial stay, plus the fare to where you are going after leaving Australia.

Educational documents	
<p>Provide evidence of all your tertiary qualifications or evidence of having successfully completed <u>at least two years of undergraduate university study</u>.</p> <p>You must provide the following evidence in both English and Chinese:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you have a tertiary qualification from China - provide Online Verification Reports from CHSI website: https://www.chsi.com.cn/ • If you are an overseas graduate - have your degrees/qualifications certified via Chinese Overseas Study Service Centre, using the website: http://zwfw.cscse.edu.cn/ • If you have not yet graduated but already completed 2 years of undergraduate study –provide Online Verification Report of Student Record from CHSI website: https://www.chsi.com.cn/, and a certified copy of your academic transcripts to support that you have completed 2 years of undergraduate university study. 	<input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/>
English language evidence	
<p>You must provide evidence of English proficiency <u>when you submit your application</u>.</p> <p>This can include a ‘functional’ English test score or a satisfactory level of academic instruction in the English language.</p> <p>You must have completed your English test within 12 months of visa application lodgment. Health requirement

Character requirement	
<p>You may have to provide a <i>Form 80 – Personal particulars for assessment</i> including character assessment and/or a penal clearance for any country you have lived in for 12 months, or longer, in the last ten years, since reaching 16 years of age.</p> <p>The office processing your application will advise you if they need these documents.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
