## **Application Checklist - CHINA**

Evidence of birth of the applicant*	
Letter of Seeking Confirmation issued by the China Center of Adoption Affairs*	
Certificate of Conformity of Intercountry Adoption*	
Certificate of abandonment of the applicant*	
Endorsed passport sized photograph of the applicant (see Form 1272 for further information)	
Evidence of all changes of name of the applicant and/or their adoptive parents (if applicable)*	
Evidence that at least one adoptive parent was an Australian citizen at the time of the applicant's adoption, such as full Australian birth certificate, or certificate of Australian citizenship or an Australian passport	
Your adoptive parent's full birth certificate if they were not born in Australia	
Evidence of any other citizenships held by the Australian citizen adoptive parent, such as a letter or certificate showing a date of acquisition of other citizenship (if applicable)*	
If the Australian citizen adoptive parent is an Australian citizen by descent, evidence that the parent was resident in Australia for two (2) years (eg. passport showing entry to Australia, school or employment records, any documents issued by an Australian Government agency)	
If there is a second adoptive parent, evidence of their citizenship status such as passport, birth certificate or identification card*	
Identity documents for the responsible adoptive parent who is applying on behalf of a child under 16 years of age which collectively show a signature, photograph and current address (such as a passport, drivers licence, credit card or utilities bill)*	
*Official English translations of any supporting documents (if not in English).
