



Where to submit your application

Information for all visa/citizenship applicants in China

The table below provides information to all visa and citizenship applicants in China about how to apply for a visa or for citizenship, and where your application will be processed.

Depending on the type of visa or citizenship you are applying for, applications can be submitted:

- online
- in person or by mail/courier to an Australian Visa Application Centre (AVAC) in China
- (in limited circumstances only) in person or by mail/courier to the Australian Visa Office in Guangzhou
- by mail/courier to a Department of Home Affairs office in Australia.
